In 2020, Jewish Volunteer Connection (JVC) has challenged the community to participate in 100,000 individual acts of service. JVC believes that every person, no matter what age, can be a part of making the world a better place.

On Passover, we learn about the Jewish people leaving slavery in Egypt. On Shavuot, we celebrate the giving of the Ten Commandments on Mt. Sinai, when Jews agreed to become a nation that followed the commandments, instead of an enslaved people that had to do everything they were told. As members of this new nation, each person became responsible for him/herself and everyone became responsible for each other.




### SUNSHINE AND CHEER
